# 1. Student Member:

- Upper level classes not required

# 2. Eminent Member:

- Outstanding engineers in the field
- Eligibility:
  - 1. Juniors: Top ¼ of their class
  - 2. Seniors: Top 1/3 of their class
- Officers:
  - 1. **President:** Has the power to call and sent notice of special chapter meetings
  - 2. Vice-President: Prepares the Induction Ceremony and plans pledge interviews (with the Pledge Chair)
  - 3. Treasurer: Signs all checks and removes funds from chapter accounts
  - 4. Secretary: Can send notices of special meetings and keeps records of member names/emails

# **BYLAWS & NATIONAL ORGANIZATION**

- Dictate we must work on events with IEEE, our sister organization
- Amendments do not immediately take place when the chapter approves them
- Individual chapters may discipline members as they see fit
- Chapter pledge fees are limited by the national bylaws
- National office locate in Piscataway, NJ
- Administrative powers are vested in "A Convention"
- Policy, Advisory, Judiciary powers are vested in "The Board of Directors"
- Legislative powers are vested in "An Executive Council"
- Membership is produced in two parts: Election and Induction
- <sup>3</sup>⁄<sub>4</sub> of the eligible membership must vote (i.e. cannot abstain) during an election of new members
- Amendments to the national constitution must be ratified by <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of College chapters
- The President, Vice-President, and Executive Secretary of the Board of Directors form the Executive Council
